A Message from the CEO

Thanks to your generous support in 2022, Children's Cancer Connection was able to serve more families than ever before! CCC served a total of 764 families statewide – an increase of 27 families. Attendance at Camp Heart Connection programs grew by 30 percent, serving more than 400 campers. Statewide programs were expanded, including a new Fall Family Outing in Eastern Iowa and a weekend Teen Camp. Exploration Expedition also grew to a full-weekend program, inviting teens from across the state to gather.


We've been in the new Jeff and Deb Hansen Home for Hope in Johnston for a full year, and it has exceeded all expectations. There's ample program space indoors and out, plenty of parking, and 100 percent of the building is accessible to all with no steps to navigate. We can host programs on-site instead of renting space. Several life-safety improvements were made, and we spruced up the exterior with new signage, paint and landscaping.

Together, we will keep moving forward in 2023! Camp Heart Connection will "Welcome Home" campers with the full return of week-long Oncology and Sibling Camps. Soon, we will begin remodeling the interior of our new facility to be more functional and child-friendly. An inclusive playground will be installed on-site, providing a fun and safe space for families to gather and connect. Comfort Connection has also been revamped to include past and current oncology patient caregivers, regardless of treatment outcome, providing a place for guardians to converse and support each other.
